#### Abstract

RESOLUTION NO. 8879 - A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO SUBMIT AN ANNEXATION APPLICATION TO THE SACRAMENTO LOCAL AGENCY FORMATION COMMISSION TO INITIATE PROCEEDINGS FOR THE FOLSOM PLAN AREA SPECIFIC PLAN PROJECT


## BACKGROUND

The Cortese-Knox-Hertzberg Local Government Reorganization Act of 2000 (Act) establishes procedures for local government changes of organization, including annexations to a city and/or detachments from affected special districts. Sacramento LAFCo has adopted Local Standards, Policies and Procedures which also guide reorganization proceedings. A reorganization means two or more changes of organization initiated in a single proposal, such as annexation and related detachments. A reorganization may be initiated by a resolution of the City Council.

In 2001, the Sacramento Local Agency Formation Commission (LAFCo) designated the undeveloped land south of U.S. 50 between Prairie City Road, White Rock Road, and the El Dorado County line as part of the City's sphere of influence (SOI). The City entered into a Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) with Sacramento County prior to LAFCo's SOI designation.

On June 28, 2011, the City Council also approved Ordinance No. 1148 - An Uncodified Ordinance of the City of Folsom Pre-zoning Approximately 3,510.4 acres of Unincorporated Property in the SOI area, and Resolution No. 8863 - A Resolution Approving the Folsom Plan Area Specific Plan. The next step in the process is to submit an application to LAFCo for annexation of the Folsom Plan Area Specific Plan project into the City of Folsom to initiate proceedings. LAFCo requires that each jurisdiction approve a Resolution of Annexation prior to submitting an annexation application.

## ANALYSIS

Staff will submit an annexation application to LAFCo consistent with the Cortese-KnoxHertzberg Local Government Reorganization Act and with the LAFCo requirements contained in Resolution Nos. 1195 and 1196, which created the Folsom Sphere of Influence south of Highway 50. This application will initiate proceedings with LAFCo.

## JOINT EIR/EIS

On June 14, 2011, the City Council approved Resolution No. 8860- A Resolution Certifying the Folsom Plan Area Specific Plan Final Joint Environmental Impact Report/Environmental Impact Statement. The City Council also adopted Findings of Fact and a Statement of Overriding Considerations and a Mitigation Monitoring and Reporting Program for the FPASP project.

## A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO SUBMIT AN ANNEXATION APPLICATION TO THE SACRAMENTO LOCAL AGENCY FORMATION COMMISSION TO INITIATE PROCEEDINGS FOR THE FOLSOM PLAN AREA SPECIFIC PLAN PROJECT

WHEREAS, in 2001, the Sacramento Local Agency Formation Commission (LAFCo) designated the undeveloped land south of U.S. Highway 50 between Prairie City Road, White Rock Road, and the El Dorado County line as part of the City's Sphere of Influence (SOI); and

WHEREAS, in 2004 and 2005, the City of Folsom held a City-wide visioning process which resulted in the Folsom Plan Area Specific Plan for the SOI area resulted in an amendment to the City Charter to outline actions required prior to approval by LAFCo under Section 7.08 of the City Charter; and

WHEREAS, an Environmental Impact Report/Environmental Impact Statement (EIR/EIS) has been prepared for the Folsom Plan Area Specific Plan, including the prezoning of the area, which EIR/EIS was certified on June 14, 2011 by City Council Resolution No. 8860, which resolution and findings are incorporated herein by reference.

WHEREAS, the Cortese-Knox-Hertzberg Local Government Reorganization Act of 2000 (Act) establishes procedures for local government changes of organization, including annexations to a city and/or detachments from affected special districts.

WHEREAS, Sacramento LAFCo has adopted Local Standards, Policies and Procedures which also guide reorganization proceedings; and

WHEREAS, a metes and bounds description of the affected property within the Folsom Plan Area Specific Plan Project has been prepared by a registered land surveyor; and

WHEREAS, a reorganization may be initiated by a resolution of the City Council; and
NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Folsom City Council that:

1. The City Manager is authorized to submit an annexation application to the Local Agency Formation Commission in accordance with the requirements of the Cortese-KnoxHertzberg Local Government Reorganization Act and the adopted Sacramento LAFCo procedures; and
2. The annexation application shall be completed pursuant to Part 3 of the Cortese-KnoxHertzberg Local Government Reorganization Act of 1985, commencing with Section 56650; and
3. The application is based upon the legal description of the boundaries of the Folsom Plan Area Specific Plan Project as provided in Attachment No. 2 and as prepared by a registered land surveyor; and
4. Consistent with LAFCO procedures and Government Code Sections 56654 and 56700, the annexation shall be consistent with the terms and conditions of LAFCO Resolution 1196; the Environmental Impact Report for the Specific Plan as certified by the City Council by

Resolution 8860 on June 14, 2011; the General Plan amendment as approved by Resolution 8861; the Specific Plan as adopted by the City Council by Resolution 8863; the Prezoning Ordinance as adopted by the City Council in Ordinance No.1148; the Development Agreement as adopted by Ordinance 1149; the Planning Studies (Transit, Drainage, Water, Wastewater and Operational Air Quality Mitigation) as approved by Resolution 8870; the Bikeway Master Plan as approved by Resolution 8878; and the terms, conditions and mitigation measures as part of each of the above described actions; and
5. The City Manager, Assistant City Manager, Community Development Director and Chief of Environmental/Water Resources are the designated contact persons representing the City of Folsom at 50 Natoma Street, Folsom, California 95630; and
6. Consistent with the Resolutions and Ordinances described above, the City of Folsom seeks to annex the described property for the reasons articulated at length in the referenced documents; and
7. The City Council submits this application and finds that the application is consistent with its Sphere of Influence application and requests that LAFCO complete its review and schedule the application for hearing and approval.
